John Kinsel, Sr.

(1921-2024) one of the Navajo Code Talkers, who helped secure an Allied victory in World War II by sending crucial messages in a code based on the Navajo language. The Navajo Code Talkers were a group of Navajo tribe members who served in the Marines, transmitting coded messages in their native language that even the most skilled Japanese codebreakers couldn't crack.

Matika Wilbur (b.1984) a Native American and photographer from Washington State. Best known for her photography book, Project 562.
