Hoda Kotb (b.1964), an American broadcast journalist, television personality, and author. She was the main co-anchor of the NBC News morning show Today from 2018 to 2025.

Farouk El-Baz (b.1938), an Egyptian American space scientist and geologist, who worked with NASA in the scientific exploration of the Moon and the planning of the Apollo program.

Dr. Alixa Naff (1919-2013),

a Lebanese-born American historian, considered the mother of Arab American studies. Much of her research focused on Arab American immigration to the U.S. at the beginning of the 20th century.
